

Resolution to Uphold a Democratic Electoral Process

WHEREAS, as a body the Edmonds Education Association supports the process of free and fair elections,

BE IT RESOLVED:

- The Edmonds Education Association commits to support free and fair elections, which includes a non-negotiable commitment to respect the will of the voters and count every vote legally cast.
- The Edmonds Education Association opposes any efforts to intimidate voters, illegitimately disqualify ballots, shut down the counting of votes, or otherwise tamper with the election results.
- The Edmonds Education Association commits to a peaceful transfer of power, in keeping with the well-established, 223-year tradition in the United States.
- The Edmonds Education Association believes that only a duly-elected president should be seated in the office on January 20, 2021, following the processes laid out in the U.S. Constitution.
- If Edmonds Education Association determines that there was election interference, the Board of Directors will call a special Rep. Assembly and a General Assembly as soon as possible. The BOD will make a recommendation for work action(s) to the Rep Assembly. The Rep Assembly will vote on the work action(s) to be put on a ballot before the General Membership.
