

2021 – 2022 EEA National Board Candidate Support Cohort Program

EEA provides facilitated support for candidates going through the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards certification process. Candidate support is optional for teachers completing their National Boards; however, teacher candidates who are part of a support program show a significantly higher passing rate.

As part of a cohort, candidates receive support, instruction, and feedback from their trained facilitators who are EEA colleagues. Examples include: “unpacking” the National Board component prompts, finding evidence of National Board standards, and alignment. Clock hours will be available.

What time are the meetings? Saturday meeting times, vary per component

Where are the meetings held? EEA office, but may switch to Zoom depending on size of group and personal situations of participants

What is the cost? Prices are based per component. See below for costs.

If a candidate is participating in all 4 cohorts in the same year, the cost is discounted to \$725.

***Foundations Course** is offered for those who did not attend the WEA Jump Start Program and is a prerequisite for Components One, Two, Three, Four, & for those receiving the OSPI conditional loan. If you attended the WEA Jump Start Program, you do not need to take the Foundations Course.

How do I register?

To register and reserve a place in the EEA NBCT Candidate Support Program please do the following:

1. Fill out the Registration form. Registration opens August 16th and continues until the component cohorts are full. A spot is guaranteed in the component cohort(s) once your \$150 registration fee is submitted to EEA.

Please note that you must register with the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards and pay their fees in addition to participating in the EEA National Board Candidate Support Program. We strongly suggest downloading the standards for your certificate area and reading them before committing to this process.

If a candidate signs up for the National Board process between June 2021 and August 2021, at a minimum, they will have access to the following types of support:

- OSPI Conditional Loan (must apply – first come, first served)
- Jump Start* (offered by Washington Education Association)
- EEA Foundations (or attendance at WEA Jump Start*)
- EEA Cohort Support for C1, C2, C3, C4
- Homestretch* (offered by Washington Education Association)

If a candidate signs up for the National Board process between September 2021 and January 7, 2022, at a minimum, they will have access to the following types of support:

- OSPI Conditional Loan (must apply – first come, first served)
- EEA Foundations
- EEA Cohort Support for C1, C2, C3, C4
- Homestretch* (offered by Washington Education Association)

If a candidate signs up for the National Board process between January 8, 2022 and the registration deadline, at a minimum, they will have access to the following types of support:

- EEA cohort support for C1, C2, C3, and C4
- Homestretch* (offered by Washington Education Association)
